Dear Members and Friends of AEFCA,

The Virus rules the world !

Our decision to cancel the Symposium 2020 in Prague early and to postpone it has turned out to be the right one,

We hope - if the virus allows it - that we can organize the next Symposium in Prague in late autumn 2021.

According to the statutes of the AEFCA, a General Assembly would be held this year combined with new elections for the board.

The term of office of the elected board ends in 2020.

AEFCA has no regulation in its statutes as to how we should proceed in this case if the General Assembly is postponed to the next year.

Against the background of the pandemic, the German legislator decided in summer this year that the General Assembly can also be held digitally in conjunction with new elections. (AEFCA is an association registered in Germany).

Several clubs and societies in Germany followed this procedure.

It quickly became apparent that this procedure led to difficulties in identifying the persons involved. As a result these elections are subject of legal proceedings in court now.

The german legislator therefore decided - in order to simplify the procedure - that the elected board members remain in office until the next General Assembly can be called.

The AEFCA plans to hold the next General Assembly during the next Symposium in Prague in late autumn 2021.

The board members remain in office until this point in time.

At the next General Assembly I will present the delegates an amendment to the articles of AEFCA, that will include this case.
